Applications returned due to time constraints: DDDC: Tree Works Application T/25/00096/TCA, Crown lift and side prune by 3-4 metres various trees at 2 Green Terrace Lees Road Stanton Lees Derbyshire DE4 2LQ – no objections

iv) **Planning updates/Issues:**

DCC Planning, DDDC – no matters, PDNPA – Minerals planner has given a response to note access routes for the restoration and promised to look at the new boundary wall.

2060 **Footpaths and Highways**

Highways – hole in road from B5056 last reported on 14th May is still unrepaired - Report 714551596. Coach lane hole filled and drain cleaned. A query on the illegality of cutting hedges before August does have caveats for obstructing street lights and where overhang is dangerous to road users.

STW main had a pressure blow out between the Chapel and our noticeboard in Stanton Lees which Severn Trent are investigating as likely connected to the new installation above the road collapse with road dig likely needed to find the main. At least one house had internal damage.

2061 **Reports and Decisions**

- i. The Green / Parish assets – hole in the wall on the housing culde sac up the side needs repair. Wreath to be ordered for 9th November Remembrance Sunday. Stickers for the defibs on The Circuit to ensure units are returned will be investigated and ordered.

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ii. Request to DDDC for additional Dog waste Bin

Our District Councillor has confirmed that the policy to add bins still remains closed.

Additional stickers were offered to remind the public that all DDDC waste bins can accept dog waste bags. Council requested that the District Councillor ask how many bins are registered and compared to actual to see if we have our entitlement.

iii. Stanton Moor Solstice

DCC response to our local observations will be challenged to establish whether the clearway is of any benefit to the event and the Police and Fire Service asked for their comments. A photo of one of the 3 blockages over the top will be forwarded.

iv. Ecobat Resources Liaison meeting

The Woodlands Plan has not come out for consultation from Ecobat although their consultant has called into a few properties with no feedback yet. No feedback on the effectiveness of the Attenuation Panels has been received – the data for which could also assist the tree for noise and light protection 5 year plans.

The planning application noted on posters on the boundary was sent back by DCC to Ecobat as needing resubmission and a new consultation period will be set when it returns. The Offsite Emergency Plan – now created, is to have an information leaflet sent to residents which is understood to be being drafted currently.
