2065 Apologies

2067 Declarations of Members Interests

2068 Public Speaking

a) Members of the public

Dog fouling in Stanton Lees near the chapel is increasing and concerns about the state of leaning trees over the highway were discussed.

b) PDNPA Parish Member Kath Potter, and PCSO Boswell sent apologies.

DCCllr Sue Hobson reported that she was still chasing the VAS system update although locally it has been seen to work on two occasions but HGV pavement mounting is still scarily prevalent. Poorly filled potholes are a growing nuisance for recurring reports. The East Midlands Mayoral Transport Vision and White Peak Loop are yet to prove of rural benefit. The response to a resident's complaint on poor parking in the village with no lights will be circulated. Please log all seen incidents of fires on the moor to DDDC to raise the profile for the PSPO infringements. Cllr Hobson left the meeting at this point.

DDDCllr Laura Mellstrom noted that DDDC pay a nominal sum towards the single PDNPA Fire Officer so deems it too expensive to provide their own wardens to enforce PSPOs. She highlighted a feasibility study for our river catchment on the reintroduction of Beavers is underway by Derbyshire Wildlife Trust.

2072 Footpaths and Highways

Highways – hole in road from B5056 is still unrepaired - Report 714551596 and will celebrate it's 1st anniversary shortly. A Tree inspection has marked up trees on Pilhough Road and will be monitored for works as this was of concern to the meeting. PROW footpath decision is awaited for the historic path.

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2073 Reports and Decisions

- i. The Green / Parish assets – Stickers for the defibs on The Circuit have been ordered.
- ii. PDNPA Liaison meetings
Local Plan Review is being circulated and comments will be submitted before 21st December deadline. Stanton Moor Liaison Group needs to meet and PDNPA will be approached for a date. The Minerals Liaison meeting is on 12th December.
- iii. Ecobat Resources Liaison meeting
The Emergency Planning Public Information sheet is still awaited but it was noted that a front cover of a Plan was included in the minutes so is hopefully on its way. Other issues await a response and the Safer intermediate meeting with the MD hasn't happened due to a change in their key liaisons. The minutes from the meeting 4 months ago arrived today and actions need chasing up.
- iv. Stanton in Peak Dog Bin reshuffle
We are allocated 4 bins on the DDDC system and propose that the yellow one is moved to the top of the village to meet the dog walkers requests and have advised of the actual locations of the other 3 on their map. A request for a bin in Stanton Lees where there are none will be added.
